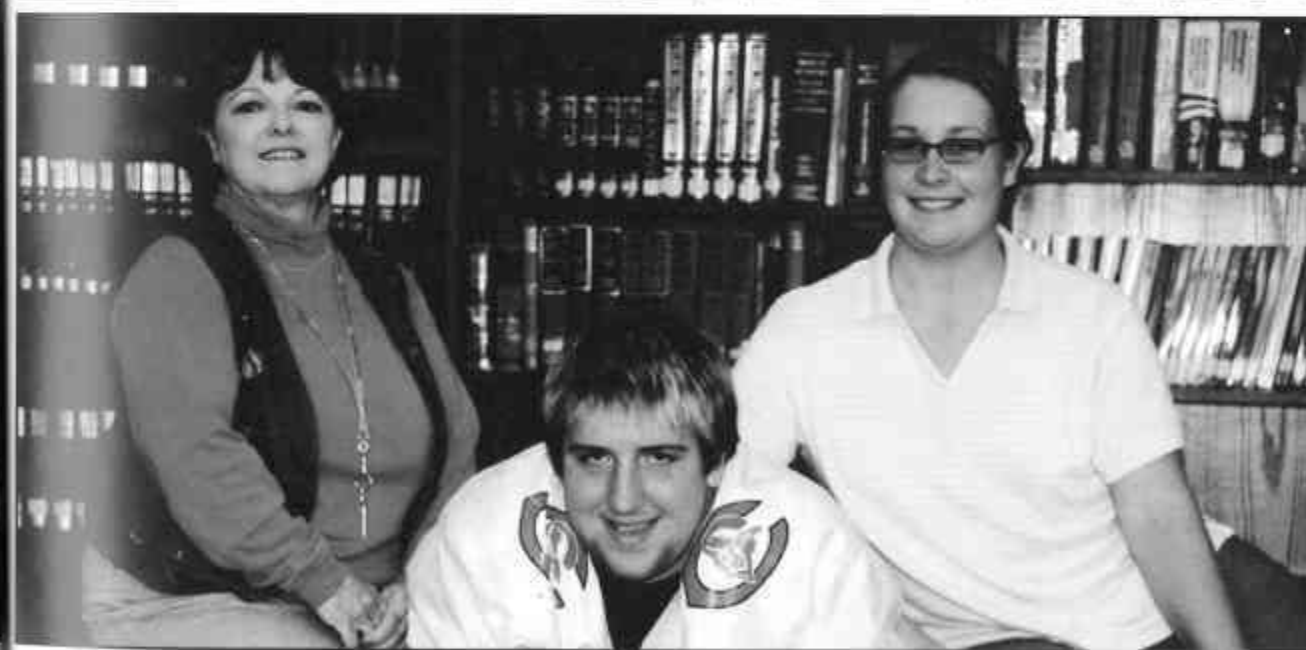

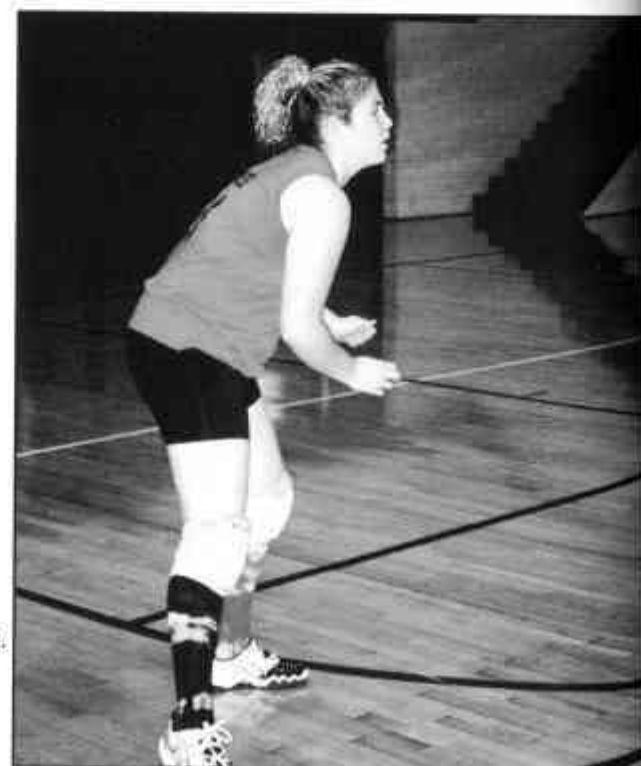

When asked what he thought of the coach, Freshman Corey Minix said, "The coach has high expectations of the players, but the players don't work to their full potential."

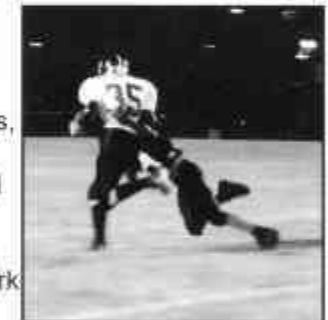

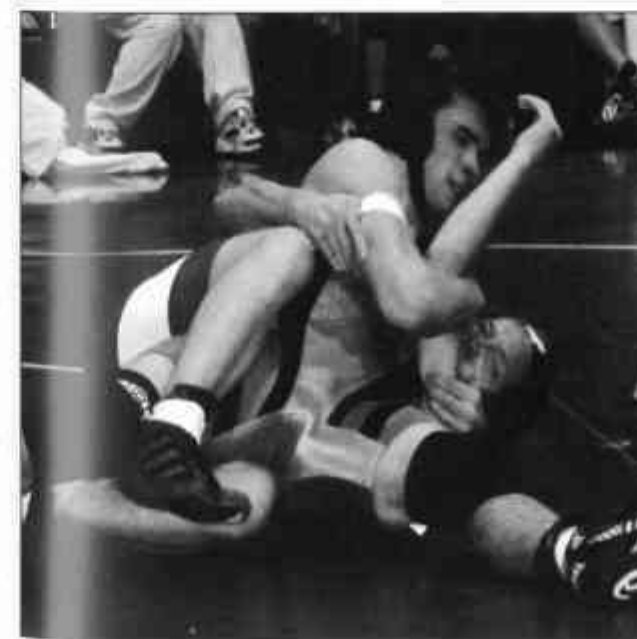

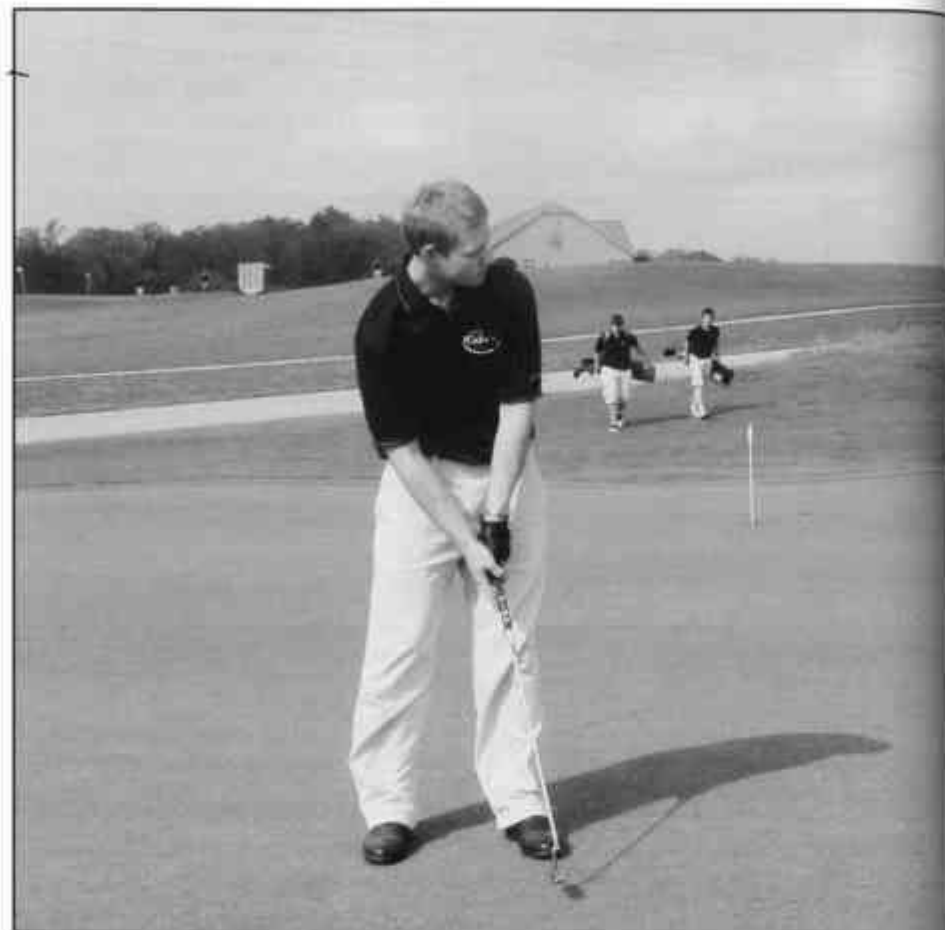

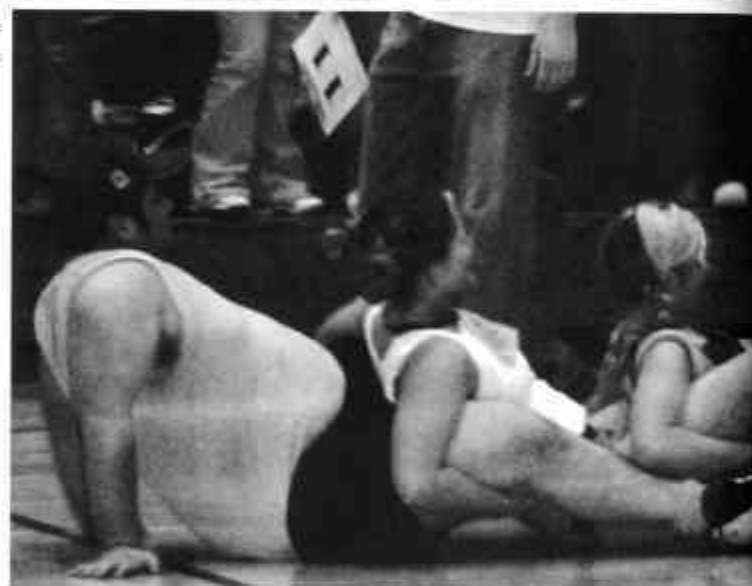

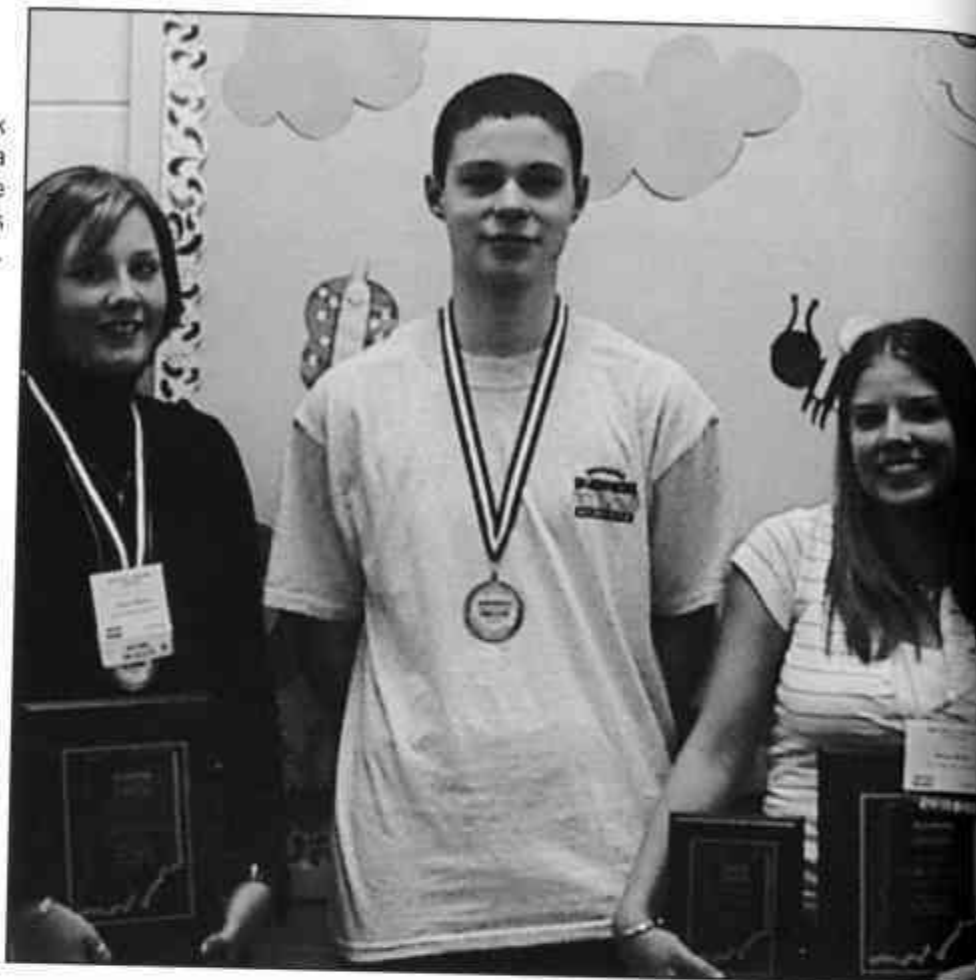

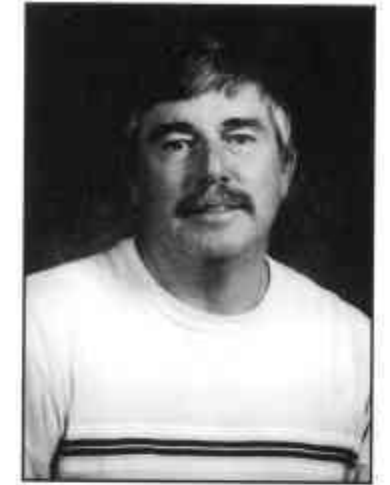
