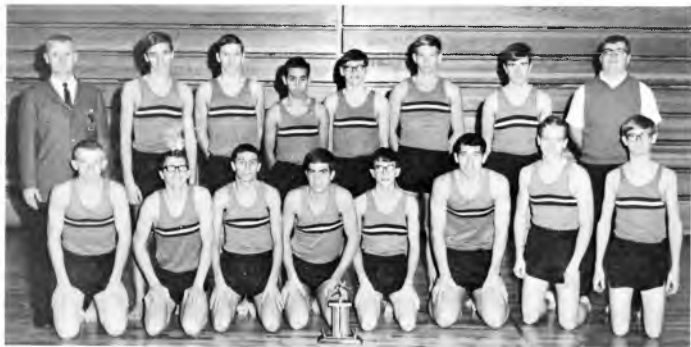
Culver Harriers Have Great Season
