Next year's squad will be a tough contender in the newly formed Three Rivers Conference. All but four of the varsity will be returning and battling for a starting position with some of the members of the B-team that finished with a record of 10-11.

The Cavalier's first win of the year was a surprise upset over Mishawaka Marian. John Glenn was Culver's next victim at Homecoming. Culver then topped South Central for their third win of the season. Oregon-Davis was blown out of Culver in the last home game in which all but one person scored.
