

St. Charles Arrow Head

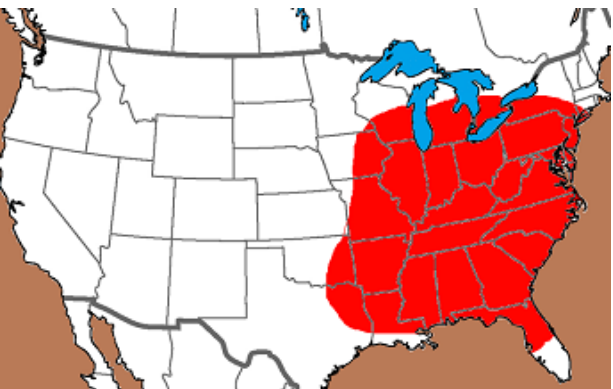

Physical Characteristics

The St. Charles arrow head has a medium to large corner notched point with an elliptical to rhomboid cross section.

Info On The Discovery

Edward G. Scully was the one to name the St. Charles. It was named for a County in Missouri in 1951. Also **Charles Elder and Robert Converse** both discovered 12 variations of the St. Charles.
